If you choose to enroll in a **Medicare Advantage Plan** during **open enrollment** and then decide shortly after you are not happy with your plan, there is something you can do. Open Enrollment ends December 7th but you do have the **Medicare Advantage Disenrollment Period** available to you. The time period for this is **January 1 - February 14**.

The Disenrollment Period is different from the Annual Enrollment Period because you can switch to another Advantage Plan. There are a few other options available. You can call a SHIP counselor at (800) 452-4800 or TTY (866) 846-0139. You can also call your local SHIP office or SWIRCA & More at (866) 400-0779.
