

SWIRCA SHIP News

Boy does time fly. It is almost **Open Enrollment** time again. Each year, from **October 15th - December 7th**, Medicare beneficiaries have the opportunity to review their health care and prescription drug plans and make changes if they choose to. We do encourage you to look over your plans and decide if your health care needs are being met at an affordable rate for you. It is good to take a look at the **prescription drug (Part D)** plan you are enrolled in and review whether all of your medications are covered under your current plan. There are assistance programs offered by the state that can help Medicare beneficiaries pay their Part A (inpatient coverage) and Part B (outpatient coverage) costs as well as Part D (prescription drug) costs. A SHIP counselor can determine whether you qualify based on your income.

If you would like to make an appointment to review your current Medicare drug or health plan, please feel free to call Melissa Meredith, a SWIRCA employee and Certified State Health Insurance Assistance Program counselor, at (812) 589-2813 or SWIRCA at 1-(866)-400-0779. SWIRCA has a SHIP office located inside the Newburgh Senior Center and will be glad to schedule an appointment for you. If you are unable to travel to Newburgh or Evansville, a SHIP counselor can meet with you closer to home. Don't let **Open Enrollment** time pass you by. Call today for your appointment.
