A Note from your Newburgh SHIP office

Most of the Medicare Part D plans have a coverage gap also known as the "donut hole". When a member enters the coverage gap there is a temporary limit on what the drug plan will cover for drug costs. Not everyone enters the coverage gap.

In 2014, the coverage gap begins after you and your drug plan have spent \$2,850 on covered drugs. Once you have reached the coverage gap and you have spent \$4,550 out-of-pocket, you are out of the coverage gap. When you get out of the coverage gap you automatically qualify for "catastrophic coverage" for Part D prescriptions for the rest of 2014.

While in the coverage gap in 2014 you will pay 47.5% of the plan's cost for covered brand name prescription drugs. This will count toward your out-of-pocket costs. In 2014, Medicare will pay 28% of the price for generic drugs during the coverage gap. You will pay the remaining 72% of the price. For generic drugs, only the amount you pay will count toward getting out of the coverage gap.

Catastrophic drug coverage in Part D will assure that you only pay a small coinsurance amount or co-payment for covered drugs for the rest of the year.

If a person qualifies for Extra Help paying for Part D costs, they will not enter the coverage gap. To see if you qualify for Extra Help call SWIRCA & More ADRC at 1-866-400-0779 or SHIP at 1-800-452-4800.
