

## SHIP NEWS

Remember that the open enrollment period for Medicare beneficiaries is October 15 through December 7.

Open enrollment is the period when a Medicare beneficiary can change or sign up for plans that can work with Medicare to help lower or pay for out of pocket expenses.

### Medicare Supplement Insurance-

A Medicare supplement insurance, sold by private companies, can help pay some of the health care costs that **Original Medicare** doesn't cover like co-payments, coinsurance, and deductibles. Medicare beneficiaries will be responsible for purchasing a separate Part D drug plan if a Medicare supplement is chosen.

### Medicare Advantage Plan-

Medicare Advantage Plans are offered by private insurance companies that are approved by Medicare. If you join an Advantage Plan, you still have Medicare. You will get your Medicare Part A and Medicare Part B coverage from the Medicare Advantage Plan instead of Original Medicare. There is usually some type of prescription drug coverage through the Advantage Plan. If there is no drug coverage then you can join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.

### Medicare Prescription Drug Plan (Part D)-

The Medicare Part D plan is offered to all Medicare beneficiaries. With the Part D drug plan either a percentage of your drug costs are covered or there may be a co-pay each time you fill a prescription at the pharmacy.

Be sure to contact your local SHIP office to make an appointment to review your Medicare insurance and/or drug plan. In the counties of Warrick, Vanderburgh, Posey, Perry, Gibson, and Spencer please call SWIRCA & More to set up your appointment time. The toll free number for SWIRCA & More is 1-866-400-0779. There are local SHIP offices in Newburgh and Evansville. There will be other sites set up around your local area during the Open Enrollment Period.
