April 15 is traditionally tax deadline day for the Internal Revenue Service. That's not the case in 2022, however, and the change has to do with a holiday in the federal capital closing city and federal offices in Washington D.C. That means the tax day deadline is getting pushed back to Monday, April 18 for everyone except residents of Maine and Massachusetts. April 18 will also be the deadline to request an automatic extension for an extra six months to file a return, although the payment of taxes remains the same.
