Spotlight on Brain Health

June is Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month, a time when people around the nation are having conversations about their own cognitive health, and discussing cognitive well-being with friends, family members, and health care professionals.

Signs and Symptoms of Stroke

What can you do to save the life of someone having a stroke? Learn the signs and symptoms of stroke. Act FAST and call 911 immediately if you suspect someone is having a stroke. Use this FAST shortcut to remember the warning signs:

FACE: Ask the person to smile. Does one side of the face droop?

ARMS: Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?

SPEECH: Ask the person to repeat a simple phrase. Is their speech slurred or does it sound strange?

TIME: If you observe any of these signs, call 911 *immediately*!



Ways to Protect Your Brain

Exercise — Walk, play with your grandchildren, or do any moderate exercise to increase your heart rate for at least 30 minutes each day.

Eat Healthy — Take advantage of the summer growing season to incorporate fresh fruits and vegetables in your diet. Consult your doctor about ways you can eat healthy, taking any medical issues you have into consideration.

Control Blood Pressure — If your blood pressure is high, speak with your doctor about ways to get it under control.

Get Plenty of Rest — Getting enough sleep is crucial for memory and critical thinking.

Engage in Social Activities — Staying connected with family and friends is beneficial for mind, body, and spirit.

Consult with your Doctor — Talk to your doctor about any changes or concerns regarding brain function.

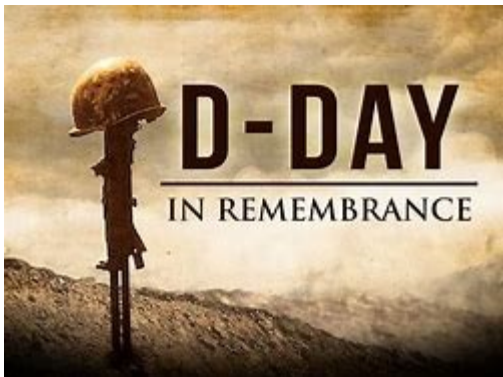


Thank You, June Day Sponsors!
