A Delicious Barbecue Fundraiser!

Get out your bib and be ready to drool! Porkapalooza 2022 is almost here. The main event is October 7 and 8, 11 am-2 pm. Pre-orders will be accepted through Monday, October 3. Payment in advance is required at Newburgh Senior Center. It's the primary fundraiser of our small non-profit organization.

If you miss the deadline for placing an order, all is not lost...

Lunches of pulled pork sandwiches, chips, and a drink will be available to the public on October 7 and 8 for \$5 each, from 11 am-2 pm, on a drive through basis. Pre-orders for lunches are not required. If you would like to order more than four lunches, please call Newburgh Senior Center at 812-853-5627 at least 30 minutes ahead of your preferred pick up time, so we can have them ready for you. You are also welcome to call in large orders during the week prior to Porkapalooza, so our volunteers know how many to prepare and the time you will need them.

Prices remain the same as last year, despite rising costs! Pork orders should be pre-paid to guarantee Newburgh BBQ Coalition smokes enough meat for everyone.


Newburgh BBQ Coalition will, for the tenth year in a row, be smoking the Porkapalooza pork products! If you hurry, you can order full slabs of ribs, tenderloins, and quarts of pulled pork (with a delicious secret sauce).

- **Full slabs of ribs are \$35**
- **Smoked tenderloins are \$15 each or two for \$25**
- **Quarts of pulled pork are \$25** (these freeze wonderfully)

Order pick up will be Saturday, October 8, 11 am to 2 pm at the Newburgh Senior Center.

To order ribs, tenderloins, and quarts of pulled pork, please call the Center at 812-853-5627 or Colleen at 812-598-8332. All orders should be pre-paid with cash or check (payable to Newburgh Senior Center).


