It has been wonderful getting to know everyone here at the NSC. Everyone has been so kind and welcoming! The second half of the year has commenced, and summer is in full swing! July was named after Julius Caesar in 44 B.C. It is, on average, the

warmest month in most of the Northern Hemisphere. The "dog days" of summer are considered to begin in early July, when the hot, sultry weather of summer usually starts. We got an early taste of it this year!

July's Full Moon on the 13th is called the "Buck Moon" by Native Americans because at this time of year, the new antlers

of the buck deer begin to appear. It's also called "Thunder Moon" due to the multitude of summer storms in July (maybe we will see some of these after our early summer drought). The Delta Aquariids Meteor Shower can be seen from July 12 to August 23, peaking on July 28-29. The Perseids Meteor Shower will be active from July 17 to August 24, although it doesn't peak until August 13.


