The first Father's Day was celebrated in the United States in 1910. It all began in the state of Washington. A woman named **Sonora Smart Dodd** came up with the idea to honor and celebrate fathers while listening to a Mother's Day sermon at church in 1909. Inspired by the success of Mother's Day, she wanted to create an equivalent holiday for male parents. Dodd went to local churches, the YMCA, shopkeepers, and government officials to drum up support for her idea. [Her efforts paid off, and Washington State celebrated the nation's first statewide Father's Day on June 19, 1910](#)¹².
