



PORKAPALOOZA 2024

Porkapalooza 2024 is just around the corner. You can almost smell the smoker. You can almost taste the ribs. This year’s fundraising event for the Newburgh Senior Center will be September 27 and 28, 11 a.m.-2 p.m. You know Porkapalooza will be here before you blink, then you’re going to want to taste that delicious pulled pork sandwich lunch on both days. Still the same price, too, at \$7 each. All lunches will be drive through, but we have outside tables you can sit at if you’re determined to eat at the Center.

New (or it’s back but updated) this year is the 50/50 up to \$2500 raffle. Tickets will be sold at the Senior Center September 2 to September 28, 9 a.m.-2 p.m. The drawing will be September 28 at 4 p.m.

Newburgh BBQ Coalition is again smoking the meats. They are just the best friends a bunch of seniors could have.

Orders for ribs, tenderloins and pulled pork will be accepted starting August 30 after the Kick Off Luncheon. All orders must be prepaid. Order forms will be available for you to take with you to get orders. If you do this, please make sure the folks keeping track can read the names and phone numbers and that you collect the correct amount of cash or checks. It’s a good idea to turn in order forms and money once a week and get a new one for the next round.

Pick up for orders will be Saturday, September 28, 11 a.m.-2 p.m. We don’t have a whole lot of room to store pork for folks who can’t pick up on Saturday, so it’s better if they have a “designated pork driver” if they aren’t available. Early pick up is not an option at this point.

The good news is the price for a rack of ribs is dropping this year, back to \$30. Quarts of pulled pork are still \$25 and tenderloins are \$15 each or two for \$25.

To order, you can call Colleen at 812-598-8332, Gail at 812-629-4634 or the Senior Center at 812-853-5627. You can either stop by to pay for your order or send payment through the mail. Only cash or checks are accepted.

Just a heads up, as usual the Center will be **CLOSED** on Friday, September 27. But, do plan to grab a 7-buck lunch from 11 a.m.-2 p.m. Donations are tax deductible.
